For the first time, the **Global Junior Challenge** ^[1] 2017 will host five European delegations (Latvia, Italy, UK, Spain and Sweden) of young men and women, aged 14-19, the Digital Ambassadors of Project **Make: Learn: Share: Europe**, implemented as part of the **Erasmus+** Programme.

Today, at the **Phyrtual Innovation Gym** ^[2] (9 am – 7 pm), the 25 project ambassadors will work in mixed teams, with one ambassador from each country, to develop a new idea of Europe.

They will have eight hours to develop innovative solutions based on the Arduino chipset, the hardware that inaugurated the free hardware era.

Borders/No Borders: How European youths would enhance a shared vision of a Europe where Europeans can enjoy a unique diversity of culture, ideas and traditions?
