CTRadio is an integral part of the greater Project **Cyberteacher** ^[3], a web site created in 2002, which gathers resources, materials and activities to employ didactic technology for learning

English.

The school web radio is used for:

- Language learning through new technology;
- Manage daily school activities (homework, communications);
- Express student opinions, interest and creativity;
- The inclusion and integration of students with different needs and/or of different nationalities, who can also produce content in their mother tongue.
